RETREAT POOL RULES

Pool Hours: 9:00 a.m. until Dusk

- The pool cannot be reserved; all residents must have equal access to the pool during operating hours. Items will be removed if left unattended for 60 minutes.
- Children under the age of 16 are to be accompanied by a responsible adult (someone over the age of 18), as required by the South Carolina Health Department.
- Anyone using the pool does so at his or her own risk. The pool does not have lifeguards.
- Pets are not allowed in the pool area.
- Disposable diapers are not allowed in the pool.
- No running, pushing, or rowdy horseplay.
- No diving.
- No solo swimming.
- Persons with open wounds should not enter the pool.
- **No glass allowed in pool area.**
- In the event of thunder and/or lightning, the pool and pool area must be evacuated. The pool will remain closed until thirty (30) minutes after the last lightning strike or thunder boom.
- The Association is not responsible for lost or stolen articles, accidents, or injuries.
- Floats - children in small floats are permitted provided child is accompanied by an adult. No adult floats.
- No smoking allowed in pool area.
- Pool guests should be limited to 8 per resident.
- Single Family homeowners must be accompanied by a bungalow or townhome owner while using the pool facility.
- No one under the influence of alcohol or drugs should use the pool.
- Please be considerate and respectful of those around you.
- Please clean up the area when you leave.
- The property owner will be held responsible for the behavior of the family, guest and renter, and any damage caused by the family, guest and renter.
- Umbrellas must be closed when you exit the pool.
